Improving the Preparation of Children for School Education on the Basis of the Curriculum in the Preschool System

Use of innovative technologies in preschool education. School lessons and playful educational activities in preschools have some peculiarities. At the same time, there is a commonality in the organization of education. All this prepares the child for active participation in school education.

The educative and developmental nature of education is a fundamental principle of education. It develops children's interest in knowledge and cognitive processes. To do this, the knowledge, skills and abilities imparted to children are gradually improved.

As a result, children learn to follow the instructions and example of adults, to apply their previous knowledge in new activities, to monitor and evaluate their own behavior, work, and behavior.

Children develop a conscious attitude to the task. Listening carefully to the educator's explanations and instructions, striving to achieve good results in their work, develops the ability to work carefully at a certain speed and consistency. Ability to work increases.

The educator must take into account the specific characteristics of each child's level of attention, thinking, memory, knowledge and skills.
